

Help Reduce the Parking Crunch

Due to the limited parking area at Atlantic County Library/Mays Landing, many library users find it difficult to park when meetings are in progress. You can help reduce the crunch by using the County parking lot behind the old courthouse on Second Street. It's a short walk to the library. (A map is provided on the back for your convenience.) This is especially helpful if your group is expecting more than 12 attendees for a weekday meeting.

Two handicapped spaces are available in the library lot for permitted vehicles. Please keep in mind that the five one-hour parking spaces are for patrons using the circulation and reference areas of the library.

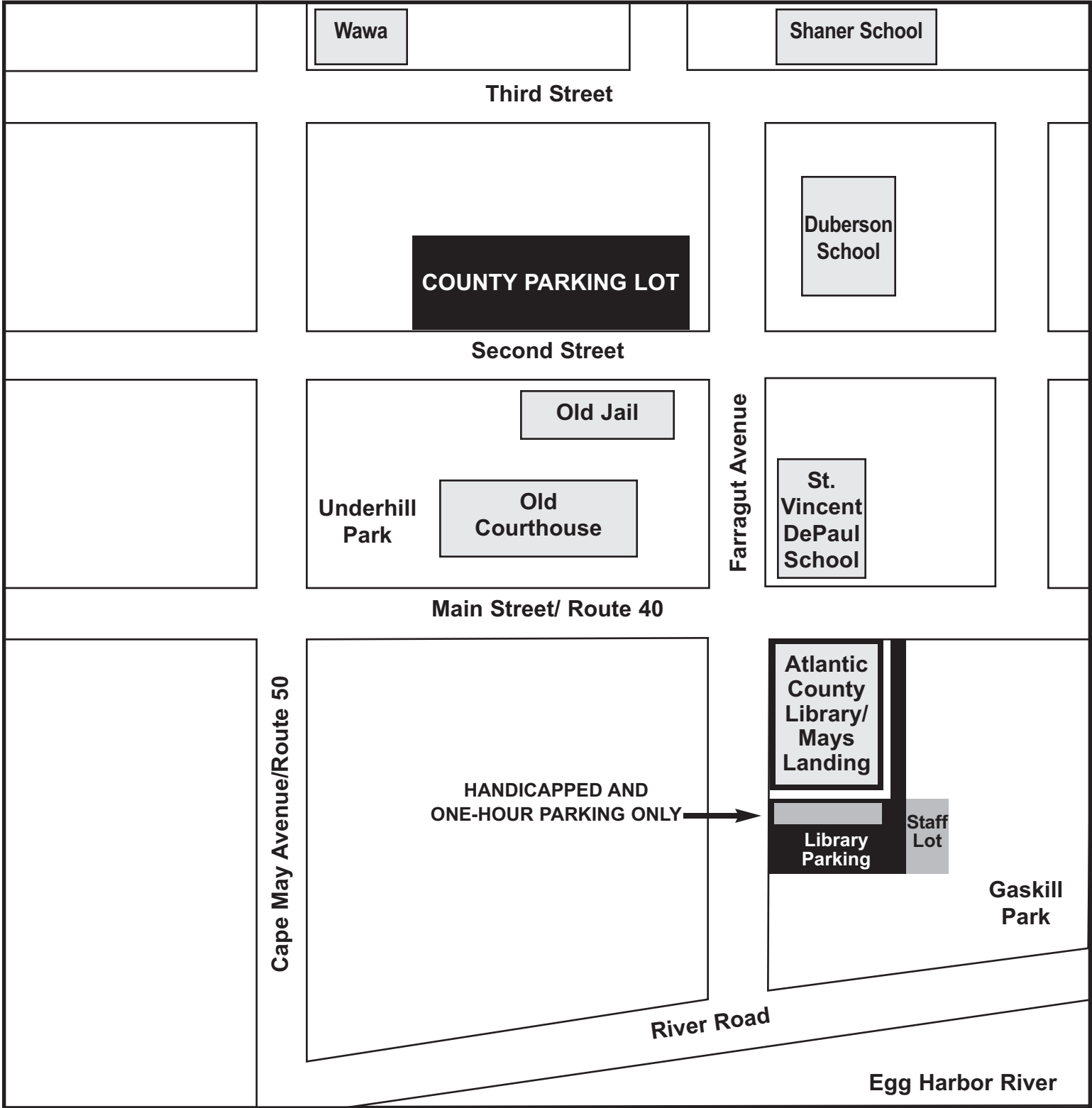
