I Elias Mason of the Townsh. of Egg Harbour in the County of Atlantic
 and state of New Jersey do this day the nineteenth day of August
 in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty seven
 Make and publish this Codicil to my last will testament bearing
 date the twenty third day of February in the year of our Lord one
 thousand eight hundred and forty three 1843

First it is my will and I do order that the twenty five dollars I
 gave to my wife Jamar Mason in trust for the use of my grand son
 John Johnson to be paid to my daughter Hannah Clark
 Second I do order that my Executor sell a certain tracts of land
 called the Somers tract which I purchased of Rachel Somers v. Lewis
 Somers containing twenty five acres also a tract of salt marsh
 lying on Keyzers Island containing about fifty acres which I gave
 to my son Solomon s. v. Elias Mason by will I now order said marsh
 sold to pay the legacies of my sons in the West and my daughters as
 specified in my will dated as above if there is a surplus above paying
 said legacies said surplus to be proportioned between my heirs in
 the West

I hereby constitute and appoint James English to this Codicil and
 my last will testament in place of John J. Mason
 In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this
 nineteenth day of August Anno Domini 1857
