Will of James Ireland

In the name of God Amen I James Ireland of great Egg Harbor
Atlantic County and state of New Jersey being of sound mind
memory and understanding (for which blessing I thank God)
do make and publish this my last will and testament in
manner following that is to say:

First It is my will and I do order that all my just debts and
funeral expenses be duly paid and satisfied as soon as con-
veniently can be after my decease,

Item I give and bequeath unto my beloved wife Esther Ireland
in addition to her right of dower at common law all my
real and personal property as long as she remains my
widow,

I give unto my son James Ireland when she ceases to be
my widow, my Farm at Maple Swamp which I purchased
of Hosea Ireland,

The land I bought of Samuel Price and Jesse Adams together
with my personal property to be divided equally between
the remainder of my children that I had by my present
wife share and share alike.

Item In case my son James should die under the age of
twenty one years and without lawful issue then I do order
and my will is the portions herein devised or bequeathed to
him shall be equally divided between the remainder of my
said children I had by my present wife in equal portions share
and share alike.

Lastly I hereby appoint my loving wife Esther Ireland my
executrix of this my last will and testament January 19th
in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty
four (1854)
