

purchasers thereof, and his, her or their heirs and assigns forever, discharged, freed and cleared of all in any trust or limitation and without liability for the part of the purchaser or purchasers his, her or their heirs and assigns as to the application non-application or mis-application of the purchase money or any part thereof and to receive the purchase money for the said premises and the same to pay and distribute among my said children Alexander Golden, Sarah Jane Collins Catharine Collins and Mary Ann Murray in equal shares and portions, and to the heirs of such of them as may have deceased, the share and portions of such deceased child or children, but should any one or more of my said children have died without leaving surviving issue, then to pay and distribute the share and portions of such one or more to and among the survivors of my said children, and until such sale shall be made by my said message and lot of ground with the appurtenances, my said Executor shall have power to let, set and demise the same and to receive and take the rents, issues and profits thereof, and to distribute the same among my said children and their heirs in equal shares and parts and in the same manner as I have hereinabove directed the proceeds of the said message or tenement and lot or piece of ground to be paid to and distributed among them.

Lastly, I do hereby nominate, constitute and appoint my friend Robert Riddle, of the City of Philadelphia - Mineral Water Manufacturer, to be Executor of this my last will and Testament, and I do direct that he or his successor in office, shall employ Joseph Abrams of the said City, Attorney at Law, as his Counsel in the Settlement of my Estate.

In witness whereof, I, the said Ann McDonald the Testatrix have to this my will consisting of two sheets of paper and more, set my hand and seal at the bottom of every sheet, this Eighteenth day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and seventy one (1871)
