Will of Hermann Neubert

Be it remembered that heretofore to wit, on the Eighteenth day of March in the year one thousand eight hundred and eighty one George H. Diehl designated as an Executor in the last will and Testament and Codicil thereto of Hermann Neubert late of the County of New York deceased, appeared in open Court before Delano G. Calrin Surrogate of the County of New York and made application to have the said last will and Testament and Codicil thereto which relates to both real and personal estate proved and in such application the Surrogate did ascertain by satisfactory evidence who were the widow, only heirs and next of kin of said deceased and their respective residences and said Surrogate did thereupon issue a citation directed to said only heirs and next of kin and to the widow who was of unsound mind and for the person having her under custody and control by their respective names stating their places of residence requiring them to appear before said Surrogate at his office in the City of New York on the Thirtieth day of March then next to attend the probate of said will and afterwards to wit, on the said Thirtieth day of March in the year one thousand eight hundred and eighty one satisfactory evidence by affidavit was adduced and presented to said Surrogate of the service of said citation in the mode prescribed by law, it being ascertained on the said day or before any proceedings were taken upon the said will that some of the parties cited were minors having no general guardian residing in the State of New York and one of persons of unsound mind having no Committee of her person and estate, a special Guardian was appointed in due form of law to take care of their interests in the matter of proving said will by an order duly entered for that purpose by said Surrogate and said special Guardian having duly appeared and on that day no one appearing to oppose the probate of said will such proceedings were thereupon had afterwards that said Surrogate took the proofs of said will hereinafter set forth and upon the first day of April in the year one thousand eight hundred and eighty one he and
