

Will of Jonas M. Smith

In the name of God, Amen, I Jonas M. Smith of Gallaway Township, Atlantic County in the State of New Jersey being of sound mind memory and understanding for which blessings I thank God do make and publish this my last will and Testament in manner following that is to say: First it is my will and I do order that all my just debts and funeral expenses be duly paid and satisfied as soon as conveniently can be after my decease.

Item, I give and bequeath unto my beloved wife Mary Smith and my Son Peter J. Smith in addition to their right of dower at common law thereof all my property real and personal namely Farm lands Wood lands, meadows, farming utensils, Horses Waggons, Household goods and of furniture of every kind and description for their use and benefit during her lifetime.

After her decease, Item, I give and bequeath unto my Son Abalam Smith his heirs and assigns forever a lot of land lying between the roads running from Smithville to Sealpoint and from Richard Risley to the Absecon road by the School House.

I give and bequeath to my Son Ezra Smith and my Daughter Mary J. Cob their heirs and assigns forever a lot of land lying in the Southern side of the road leading from Richard Risley to the Absecon road joining lands of Johnathan Soy running - his line Southernly from the road to the first tall rock with woods thence make a corner and run straight to Eunice Dolbow Southeast corner up said line straight with Mary J. Cob's west line to be equally divided between them share and share alike.

I give and bequeath to my Son Abalam Smith and my Daughter Eunice Dolbow their heirs and assigns forever a lot of land lying in the Southern side of the road leading from Richard Risley to the Absecon Road joining Eunice Dolbow line and Mary J. Cob's west line running Southernly to the line running to Eunice Dolbow Southeast corner.

her heirs and assigns forever one acre wood land in the South end of my Farm joining Johnathan Smith lot running from my west line to my East line I give and bequeath unto my Son Johnathan Smith one acre wood land in the South end of my Farm joining lands of Risley Smiths heirs and Christian Liberson running from my west line to my East line. I give and bequeath unto my Son Albert J. Smith his heirs and assigns forever one acre of land joining Mariah Libersons running from my west line to my East line.

I give and bequeath to my Daughter Sally Willson her heirs and assigns forever one acre and a half one the North end of my Farm running from my west line to my East line joining lands to James B. Soy's heirs.

I give and bequeath unto my Son Johnathan Smith his heirs and assigns forever one acre and a half in the North end of my Farm joining Sally Willson's lot running from my west line to my East line.

I give and bequeath to my Son Johnathan Smith his heirs and assigns forever my undivided part of a lot of land meadow lying in the North side of flats creek known by the name of Jay creek meadow.

I give and bequeath unto my four Sons Abalam Smith Ezra Smith, Albert Smith and Johnathan Smith to their heirs and assigns forever a lot of Salt meadow lying Easternly of Murries creek joins Motts creek and thence along Duck creek, to be equally divided share and share alike.

I give unto my Son Peter J. Smith his heirs and assigns forever the Farm's now line in, except what has been bequeathed the wood lands belonging to the said Farm I give to my Son Peter J. Smith his heirs - a lot of Salt meadow joining Murries creek running Westernly along Motts creek thence along Wigram creek in to Seulls Point to the South line of my land in that tract, I give to my Son Peter J. Smith his heirs and assigns forever a lot of wood land lying along the road leading from Sealpoint to the South corner Farmers Park, I give and bequeath unto my Son Peter J. Smith his heirs and assigns forever
