Fourth. I hereby revoke the appointment of Arthur M<sup>r</sup> Elroy as one of the Executors of my said will, and do hereby declare that it is my will and hereby direct that my said wife Catharine Kelly shall be the sole executrix thereof and of the Codicil thereto.
