

said sum of five thousand five hundred dollars aforesaid shall merge in my general estate and shall be dealt with as directed in my said Last Will and Testament.

I also order and direct that my beloved wife the sole executrix of my Last Will and Testament be empowered to change the securities and investments of which I may die seized in such manner as shall seem to her best adapted to insure their safety.

Codicy - I desire that this Codicil may be annexed to and made a part of my last Will and Testament, hereby ratifying and confirming the same in all parts except as altered in this Codicil.
