

all my property and estate, both real and personal, in whatever it may consist, or wherever situate, during the lifetime of my mother in law, Margaretha Fischer: In trust that they, and the survivor of them will, during the life of my said mother-in-law, permit her to have, hold, receive, use and enjoy the rents, interest, issues and profits thereof; and after the decease of my said mother-in-law, I do give, devise and bequeath all my said estate to the said Walburga Ertell, to her, her heirs and assigns forever, subject to the payment of the sum of two hundred dollars to my sister-in-law, Josephine Erdmann of Paso Robles, San Luis Obispo Co, California, in one year after the decease of my said mother-in-law, and I do hereby give the said sum of two hundred dollars to my said sister-in-law, and charge my said estate with the payment thereof, making it liable to be sold to raise the said sum, in case the said Walburga Ertell shall not pay the same as aforesaid; And in case my said mother-in-law shall not be living any more at the time of my decease, then I give, bequeath and devise all my property and estate, real and personal, which shall belong to or be owned by me at the time of my death, to the said Walburga Ertell, to her, her heirs and assigns, subject to the payment of the aforesaid sum of two hundred dollars to my said sister-in-law, Josephine Erdmann, in one year after my decease, in the manner aforesaid.

Third - I constitute and appoint William Morgenweck sole executor of this my last will and testament, revoking all former wills by me made.
