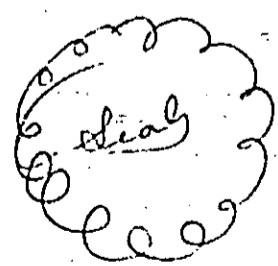

Also all my interest in a Farm with buildings thereon near Egg Harbor City in Atlantic Co. New Jersey according to Deed and also the value of certain mortgages I hold on property in the above Egg Harbor City as all recorded in Deeds landing in the above County in New Jersey.

Also all my interest in Policy No. 2157 of National Capital Life Insurance Company of Washington D.C.

Also all my interest in Policy No. 68697 of North Weston Mutual Life Insurance Company of Milwaukee, Wis. to my wife Louisa Augusta, born Schmidt and my two children Charles Louis born April 15th 1862 and John Henry born November 28th, 1864 both in Boston in the following manner:

My wife is to take charge of the whole, for the purpose of supporting and educating our two children, to the best of her deciding and to the consent of my brother John Henry Julius Hincke.

But in case my wife is to be married again, then the whole of my property is to be divided in three equal parts amongst her and our two children also subject to the consent and approval of my brother named above.
