

they have a proper place for them, I give the organ to Hannah conditioned that she make good use of it and in case this condition be violated then the organ shall be sold and the proceeds paid over to my wife Maria for her own use I desire that Eliza Ann shall have the picture of the Old Arm Chair, provided however that she first settle her indebtedness to me.

Fourth. All the rest residue and remainder of my Estate, including Household Goods and Chattels and Premise Nos 707 and 709 Richmond Street excepting however the Hammonton Land, I give devise and bequeath to my wife Maria for the term of her natural life it being my desire and wish that the said Estate shall be so used and managed as to give my said wife a proper and comfortable living, If there shall be any remainder after my said wife has had her proper maintenance then I give devise and bequeath the same unto my daughter Bizzie Anderson and her children their and each of their heirs and assigns forever.

Fifth. As to the Hammonton Land which consists of Ten Acres at Old Hammonton and two lots at East Hammonton above excepted, it is my desire that my wife shall retain the deeds until she deems it advisable that a conveyance shall be made thereof, at which time I direct my Executrix herein after named, to convey the said property unto Eliza Ann and Hannah Tellow their heirs and assigns. Provided however that said conveyance shall be made after the said Hannah Tellow arrives at the age of twenty one years, if the said Eliza Ann and Hannah shall desire it, my said wife in the meantime shall pay the taxes as they become due, In conclusion, I desire that Hannah have the option of remaining with my said wife and it is my wish that she do so as long as they can agree.

Sixth. I appoint my wife Maria Harrison Sole Executrix of this my last will and Testament In Witness Whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal the sixteenth day of January, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty six (1886)
