

Germany an annuity of One hundred dollars per annum to be paid to my sister in equal quarterly payments, out of the interest of the personal property left, after the legacies hereinbefore mentioned have been paid, and in case the interest of said personal property shall not amount to the sum of one hundred dollars per annum, then the amount of the interest actually realized from said principal sum shall be added to said principal sum, and my said sister Caroline Raisig shall receive therefrom one hundred dollars per annum in equal quarterly payments. In case of the sickness of my said sister or should she ever be in destitute circumstances, I direct that my said sister Caroline Raisig be supported during such sickness or so long as such destitute circumstances shall continue; The necessity thereof however shall be decided by my nephew Louis Frick.

Sixth after the death of my said sister Caroline Raisig my Executor is hereby directed to send to the authorities at Schwalbach, Oberamt Weinsberg, in Württemberg Germany, the sum of one thousand (1000) guilder which sum is equal approximately to Four hundred dollars United States money and I hereby give and bequeath to the said authorities of Schwalbach, Oberamt Weinsberg in Württemberg, Germany the said sum in Trust to invest the same and to spend the yearly interest thereof in buying and distributing bread or bread and meat to the aged and poor people of said Schwalbach, on tenth day of February in each and every year as a remembrance of my mother's birthday.

Seventh I direct that all the rest, residue and remainder of my estate real and personal shall be divided into seven equal parts and I give, devise and bequeath one of such parts respectively unto Louis Frick of number 244 Race Street Philadelphia Pennsylvania, unto Wilhelm Frick of Altensteig Oberamt Nagold, Württemberg Germany and unto Minna Frick (now Finkenbeina) of said Altensteig that is to say:

the said Louis Frick, Wilhelm Frick and Minna Frick (now Finkenbeina) each taking one of said seven shares.

I give devise and bequeath unto the heirs of Sophia Frick (or Durr) deceased now in Germany,

one of said seven shares to be divided amongst them equally.

I give devise and bequeath unto Carl Frick (whose residence is now unknown) one of said seven shares, and I direct that until said Carl Frick shall claim said one share the same shall be loaned in equal amounts to Louis Frick Wilhelm Frick and Minna Frick (now Finkenbeina) and to the heirs of Sophia Frick (or Durr) deceased. And in the event that the said Carl Frick shall not claim the one share of my estate hereby given devised and bequeathed unto him within ten years after my decease, then and in that case I give devise and bequeath the said one share in equal parts unto Louis Frick, Wilhelm Frick Minna Frick (now Finkenbeina) and to the heirs of Sophia Frick (or Durr) deceased, equally. The said Louis Frick Wilhelm Frick, Carl Frick, Minna Frick (or Finkenbeina) and Sophia Frick (or Durr) are the children of my deceased sister Friederike Frick and the bequests and devise made in this seventh clause of my last Will and Testament are to them and their heirs and assigns forever and I direct that the loans in this seventh clause of my Will shall be made without taking security of any kind therefore. I give, devise and bequeath to Elizabeth Rieker (now Sprick) of Alleghany City Pennsylvania the interest of one of said seven shares of my Estate for and during her natural life, and at her death I give, devise and bequeath the said share unto the children of the said Elizabeth Rieker; But if the said Elizabeth Rieker shall die leaving no issue, then I give, devise and bequeath the said share unto the children of her brother Carl Rieker equally I give, devise and bequeath unto Carl Rieker of number 76 Montele Street Alleghany City Pennsylvania the interest of one of said seven seven shares of my estate until the youngest child of said Carl Rieker shall attain the age of Twenty one years; I give, devise and bequeath unto the said children of Carl Rieker one of said seven shares of my estate to be divided amongst them equally share and share alike.
