

real, personal and mixed, shall then be divided equally between such of my children (including among the number my daughter Emma Cecilia Metzger, daughter of my husband by his first marriage) as shall be living, or, if deceased, as shall have children then living surviving them, or either of them, and that the children of any of my said children (including my two daughters now married, namely Martha Matilda Archambault and Mary Agnes Gould) so deceased, shall take the share this her or their mother would have taken if living. And in like manner, should all of my three unmarried daughters (including among the number my daughter Emma Cecilia Metzger, daughter of my husband by his first marriage). For which I have above provided, be deceased or married, then division of the entire principal of my estate shall in like manner be made among all such of my children (including Emma Cecilia Metzger) as shall then be living, or if deceased, as shall have children then living surviving them or either of them and that the children of any of my said children so deceased shall take the share this her or their mother would have taken, if living.

Thirdly:- My executors and trustees herein after named shall have full power and absolute discretion, not alone in the case above provided, but at all times, to sell, convert and reinvest any of my estate, real, personal or mixed, in like manner as in above case provided.

Lastly:- I appoint my brother Andrew B. Cochran and my daughter Eliza Jane Cochran Metzger, Executors of and trustees under this my last will and testament.
