

Margaret R. Massey and I direct my executors to pay to them the Income of her share of my estate and their receipts therefore shall be a sufficient discharge for such payments from her trust estate.

Eighth - I authorize and empower my Executors to sell and dispose of my real estate wherever situate and any part thereof either at public or private sale for what they think the best price that can be obtained for the same and to grant and convey the same by good and sufficient conveyances unto the purchaser or purchasers thereof in fee, free and discharged from all trusts, annuities, life estates or legacies therein given and without liability upon the part of the purchasers thereof to see to the application of the purchase money. I authorize and direct my Executors to act as such in all of the United States or elsewhere in which I have or may have property, and I do hereby will direct and declare that they shall so act in said United States or elsewhere as Executors or Administrators with the will annexed or otherwise without their being compelled or required to give any bonds or security whatever I hereby releasing and relieving them from all such requirements.

Ninth - I nominate and appoint my son Walter Shelton Massey and my friend James W. Hall as the Executors of this my last Will and Testament.
