Item. I give and Bequeath all my household goods, furniture &c contained in both of my said Messuages 3153 Mantua Avenue and 209 Arctic Avenue unto the said Grace C. Burger absolutely and forever.

Item. I give and bequeath my gold watch to my friend Jacob S. Isaac of New York City absolutely and I give and bequeath my gold chain to my friend James B. Agnew of Philadelphia absolutely, if they shall both be living at the time of my death; but in case of the death of either of them before me, then I give and bequeath the said gold watch and gold chain to the survivor of them absolutely.

Item, All the rest, residue and remainder of my Estate of what nature or kind and wherever the same may be at the time of my decease I give, devise and bequeath unto my Brother Morris Heilbron, now of New York City and to his Heirs, Executors, Administrators and assigns forever.
