

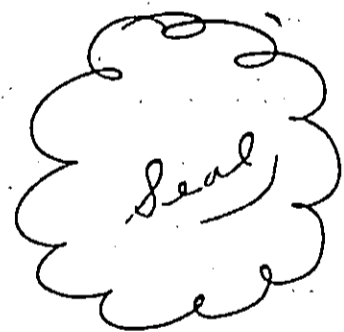
Atlantic County Surrogate's Office

I, H. Purzner of Galloway Township, Atlantic Co. N. J. being of sound mind and reason do hereby declare this instrument of writing to be my last will and testament and revoke all former ones.

1. I give and bequeath to my beloved wife, Katherine Purzner, as her dower three hundred dollars (\$300.00) to be given to her one year from date of my death.
2. I give and bequeath to my first son, Christ. Purzner fifty dollars (\$50.00);
3. I give and bequeath to my second son, George Purzner, ten dollars (\$10);
4. I give and bequeath to my third son, Chas. Purzner one hundred dollars (\$100.00)
5. I bequeath to my youngest son, John Leonh. Purzner, all of my real estate, viz: farm lot of twenty acres, situated on the north corner of Manheim Ave and Leebig Str., known and designated as farm lot, numbered five hundred and thirty four (534), of Galloway Township, Atlantic Co. N. J. and that tract of land in Galloway Township Atlantic Co., N. J., designated as meadow parcel no 32 on the plan of the division of lands of Gloucester Farm and Town Association, containing five acres more or less together with all my personal property, provided he will pay all my indebtedness, my funeral expenses and the sums of money bequeathed to my wife and other sons respectively.
6. & last I appoint my son, John Leonh. Purzner of this my last will and testament.
