

share (of about sixteen (16) Acres each) of an undivided Ninety six (96) Acres of land be the same more or less situate in said Town of Hammonton, and lying on the Northeast side of Old Columbia Road, described in a deed from Martha Ann Thomas, Geo. G. Horn and others to Maryborn dated March 23rd 1886 and recorded in Book 111 of Deeds folio 206 in the Clerk's Office of Atlantic County at Mays Landing N. J. to be given as follows - The said lot to be divided between lines running parallel with the northerly line of said tract and each to have a sufficient front on Old Columbia Road, to make sixteen Acres $\frac{1}{6}$ of the whole tract, in the following orders.

The first sixteen Acres on the North end of said tract I give to George G. Horn for his use during his natural life, and at his death the same shall go to his heirs and to their use forever.

The second sixteen Acres, I give to Mary R. Bird to her, her heirs and assigns forever

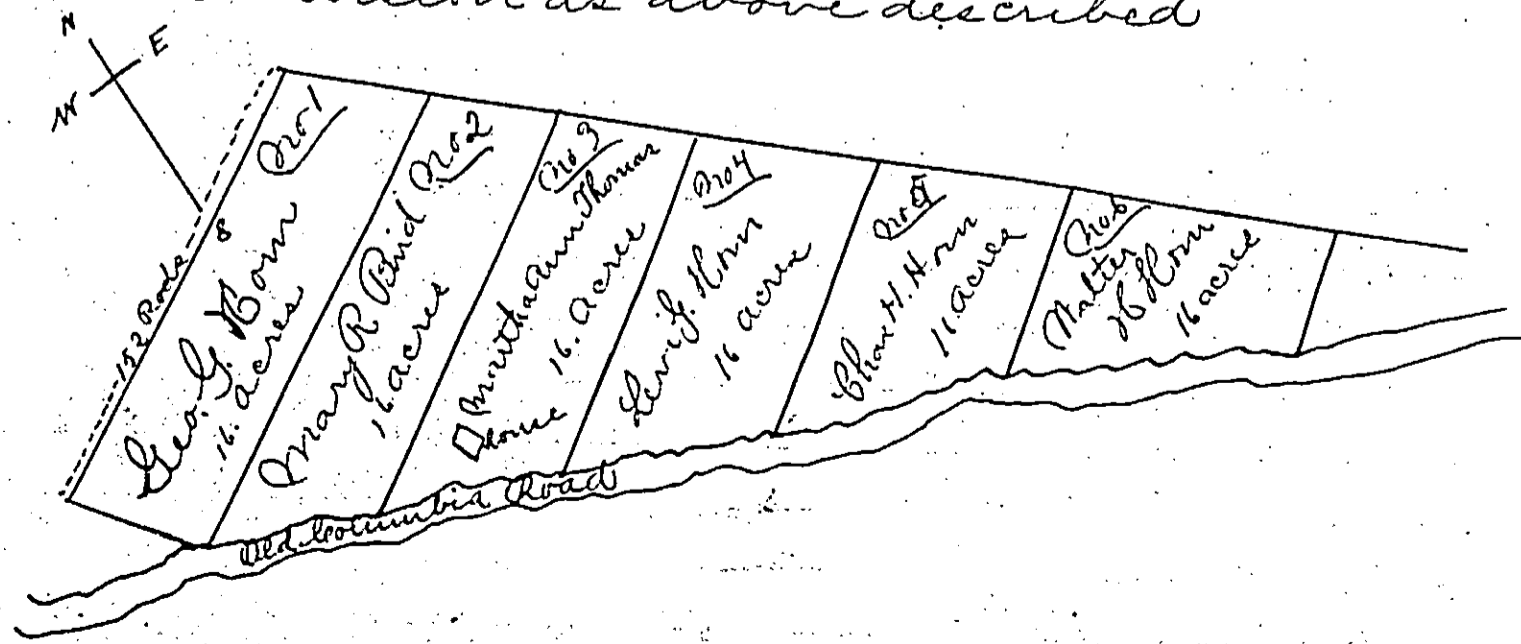
The third sixteen Acres which include all the buildings on that side of said Columbia Road, I give to Martha Ann Thomas, to her and her heirs and assigns forever

The fourth sixteen Acres lying South of the third I give to Levi G. Horn, to him his heirs and assigns forever

The fifth lot of sixteen Acres, lying South of the fourth, I give to Charles B. Horn, to him his heirs and assigns forever

The sixth, and last lot of sixteen Acres lying South of the fifth I give to Walter H. Horn for his use during his natural life; and at his death, the same shall go to his heirs and to their use forever

The following is a rough draught, indicating the shape and division as above described



Third. I hereby nominate and appoint my son Levi G. Horn executor of this my last will and testament
 In witness whereof, I have hereto set my hand and seal this fourteenth day of August A.D. 1886

I, Mary Horn of the town of Hammonton County of Atlantic and State of New Jersey do this tenth day of March - A.D. 1888 make and publish this codicil to my last will and testament in manner following, that is to say,

First, I wish to change the order in which I distributed my real estate, and give to Charles B. Horn, the sixteen Acres lying South of the lot heretofore devised to Martha Ann Thomas being lot No 4, in the order of giving or devising, as set forth in the will dated August 14th 1886, and being the same therein devised to Levi G. Horn; and to Levi G. Horn I give and devise the sixteen Acres before given to Charles B. Horn, being the fifth in the order of giving or devising, and to Levi G. Horn I also bequeath the feather bed and pair of pillows and to my daughter Mary R. Bird, I give and bequeath one feather bed and one table, the same to be taken from the personal property hereinbefore given and bequeathed to Martha Ann Thomas
