Item 4th

I give and bequeath unto my wife Harriet Leonard all my estate real and personal to have and to hold the same to her for her life during all the term of her natural life directing her to pay out of the same to my sister Elizabeth W. Austin the sum of six dollars per month as long as both my wife and my sister Elizabeth are alive also to pay for her sickness and funeral expenses a sum not exceeding seventy Five (75) Dollars I also direct that if at any time the income from my estate should be inadequate for the support of my wife and the payment to my sister as directed above then my wife shall have full power and authority to sell so much of my estate real or personal as may be required for her support and to make the payments to my sister Elizabeth W. Austin shall cease with her death or the death of my wife Harriet Leonard

Item 5th

I direct that after the death of my wife Harriet Leonard all of my property real and personal shall be sold by my executor with this will attached with as full power to make absolute conveyance of the same as I could do if living and after paying thereout my wife's funeral expenses the expense of her last sickness and tomb stones for her grave to pay and distribute the balance remaining from the sale of the property as follows - namely

Item 6

if my sister Elizabeth W. Austin be living at the time of my wife's death and the sale of distribution of my estate I direct that my executor shall safely invest the sum of two thousand (2000) Dollars for her benefit and to pay the interest accruing therefrom to her sum quarterly so long as she shall live and to pay from the principle the expenses of her last sickness for her funeral and for tomb stones for her grave or sum not exceeding Two Hundred (200) Dollars and at her death the balance remaining shall be given to my sister Emma A. Taylor and her children as follows Emma A. Taylor Five Hundred (500) Dollars her daughter Amelia B. Taylor Five Hundred (500) her son William B. Taylor Two Hundred (200) Dollars and her other two sons Jacob Leonard and Thomas B. Taylor each Three Hundred (300) Dollars should any of the above

be dead then their heirs shall inherit the sum such one would be entitled to if living

in case my sister Elizabeth W. Austin be not living at the time of the distribution of my estate then I direct that my sister Emma A. Taylor and her children be paid the beqacis as above directed and the residue of the Two Thousand (2000) Dollars mentioned in this item shall be equally divided between Emma A. Taylor and her children as named above share and share alike each residue shall be so divided whenever distribution is made of the money mentioned in this item share and share alike

Item 7

After making the investment as directed in item 6 for the benefit of my sister Elizabeth and Emma and her children I direct that the balance remaining from the sale of my estate shall be divided as follows to my sister Emma A. Taylor Five Hundred (500) Dollars and Elizabeth W. Austin Five Hundred (500) Dollars to my wife's brothers Jonathan T. Lewis One Thousand (1000) Dollars J. R. Hobart Lewis Five Hundred (500) Dollars Abel Lewis Lewis Five Hundred (500) Dollars Isaac Lawrence Lewis Five Hundred (500) Dollars or should either of them be dead their heirs shall receive such sum as he or she would be entitled to if living

To my nephews

Leon D. Dibelier and his brother Leonard Hansell Dibelier I give and bequeath to each one One Thousand (1000) Dollars should either of them die without leaving a wife child or children then his share shall revert the other or should both die without leaving wife child or children then I direct that the shares of both shall be given to the children of my sister Emma or their heirs share and share alike in no case is their father John B. Dibelier to be considered as having any interest whatever in the money I bequeath to his sons Leon and Leonard Dibelier
