

Will of William H. Sowers.

I, William H. Sowers of Germantown in the City
of Philadelphia, State of Pennsylvania, do make and
publish my last will and Testament in manner fol-
lowing, to wit.

First - I direct all my just debts and funeral
expenses to be paid as soon as possible, and I
desire that all matters connected with my funeral
shall be of a plain and private character, and that
only my immediate friends shall be present thereat.

Second - I direct my executors to pay the sum of One
Dollar per annum out of my estate as long as
the same shall remain in their hands to
keep the Family Lot at Laurel Hill in order and
repair.
