Lake late of said County of Atlantic, hath died, having first made his last Will and Testament in writing, which hath been duly proved before the Surrogate of said County of Atlantic, and the same entered of record. And whereas, said testator hath appointed the said Ezra B. Megroungle who resided out of the State of New Jersey, and in the State of Pennsylvania as one of the executors thereof, to whom letters testamentary are about to be granted thereon, by the Surrogate of said County of Atlantic, -

Now Therefore, if the said Ezra B. Megroungle one of the executors named in the said last Will and Testament of the said Jesse S.
