

Seventh. I give and bequeath absolutely unto my daughter Mary Elizabeth Lippincott wife of Joshua W. Lippincott my place No. 1624 Mount Vernon Street subject to a ground rent of (Five thousand Dollars principal). \$300 per annum belonging to her mother in her own right subject however to the payment by her my said daughter Mary E. unto my executors the sum of Two thousand dollars.

Eighth. All the rest residue reversion and remainder of my estate Real and Personal whatsoever and wheresoever I give devise and bequeath unto all my children that shall be living at the time of my decease and the lawful issue of such of them as may then be deceased their heirs, executors, administrators and assigns forever in equal parts and shares, so nevertheless that such issue take and receive such part and share only as his, her or their deceased parent would have taken and received if then living.

Ninth. From and immediately after the decease of my said wife I give devise and bequeath the income of the said properties named in the Fourth Item of this will and testament unto all my children and the lawful issue of such as may be deceased their heirs, executors, administrators and assigns in equal parts and share so nevertheless that such issue take and receive such part and share only as his, her or their deceased parent would have taken and received if then living during the natural life of either of my children and from and after the decease of my last child I direct that the said properties be considered as a part of the rest, residue, reversion and remainder of my estate and divided as directed in the eighth Item of this my last will and Testament.

Tenth. I hereby nominate constitute and appoint my son Israel H. Parry and my son in law Henry H. Lippincott and Joshua W. Lippincott, Executors of this my last will and testament and I do hereby authorize direct and empower them and the survivor of them if in their or his discretion they may deem it best for the interests of my estate to sell and dispose of all or any part of the Real Estate of which I may die seized, either solely or as Tenant in common with others at public or private sale or sales of such price or prices and on such terms and conditions as may seem best, and to grant, convey and assign the same to the purchaser or purchasers thereof his, her or their heirs and assigns, forever free from any liability or responsibility for or on account of the

application, non application or mis application of the purchase moneys, and the money's arising from such sale or sales to be applied for the purposes after my will.

Eleventh. I hereby revoke all former wills by me made and declare this only to be and contain my last will and testament.
