Lafferty absolutely she to assume liability for and relieve my estate from all liability by reason of the Bond and Mortgage executed by me secured thereon.

I direct that the sum of Three hundred Dollars be expended by my executors in their discretion for masses for the repose of my soul.

All the rest residue and remainder of my property I give devise and bequeath unto my three children share and share alike absolutely.
