

husband for or on account of any of his debts, contracts or engagements and from and after the death of my said husband, upon the further trust to pay over the said net income one fifth thereof to Samuel B. Gee, one fifth thereof to Albert O. Gee, one fifth thereof to Frank H. Gee and one fifth thereof to Harry J. Kirby, being the children of my said husband, but however, that the share, of the net income coming to each of the said children of my husband, as aforesaid shall not be liable to anticipation, mortgage, assignment or transfer by the respective parties entitled thereto or either of them or be subject to attachment, execution or seizure of any kind by any creditor of either of said children, and the other one fifth to Florence Potter, Ellen Potter, Albert Potter and Willie Potter, children of my husband's deceased daughter, Mrs. Emma Potter in equal parts or shares during their minority, and as they shall respectively attain the age of twenty-one years, to pay over to each child so attaining the age of twenty-one years one fourth of one fifth of the principal of my said trust estate; and when and as each of the children of my husband shall depart this life, then to pay and distribute one fifth of the principal of my said trust estate equally to the children of the said deceased child, but should either of my husband's children die without leaving issue him or her surviving, then the part or share that would have gone to his or her children had they left issue then surviving, shall go to and be divided between the issue of the other children of my husband and above named, such division to be per stirpes and not per capita and to be made at the same times or times as they would be entitled to take their own share under the terms of this will, so that the whole of the principal of the said Trust Estate shall to or have been distributed

immediately upon the death of the last of the four children of my husband above named.

Third; I hereby nominate, and appoint Frank H. Gee and Samuel B. Gee to be the executors of this my last will and testament, and hereby revoke, any and all other wills by me at any time heretofore made.
