4th When the estate is settled there shall be retained out of the whole amount before the estate has been divided the sum of one hundred dollars which is to be invested at the highest rate of interest and the said interest or income from the said sum to be used in keeping the cemetery lot in Gloucester City N. J. in good order.

And as to all the rest, residue and remainder of my Estate, real personal or mixed of what ever nature or kind, or wherever situate at the time of my decease, I do hereby give, devise and bequeath

and lastly, I do make constitute and appoint Annie C. Harley to be the Executrix of this my last Will and Testament, hereby revoking all former Wills by me at any time heretofore made, and declaring these presents only to be and contain my last Will and Testament.
