Lastly I do hereby nominate, constitute & appoint my beloved wife M. Elizabeth Hentz and my son Percy R. Hentz Executors of this my last Will & Testament, hereby revoking any and all wills by me at any time heretofore made, and do declare this only to be and contain my last Will & Testament.
