The condition of this obligation is, That if the said Margaretta P. Spayd Executor of the last Will and Testament of Thomas D. Groves deceased, shall make a true and perfect inventory of all and singular the goods, chattels and credits of the said deceased, being within this Commonwealth, which have come or shall come to her hands, possession or knowledge,

or unto the hands and possession of any other person for her and the same so made to exhibit into the Office of the Register of the County of Philadelphia, within thirty days from the date hereof, and the same goods do well and truly administer according to law, and make a just and true account of all her actings and doings therein, in one year from the date hereof, or when thereunto lawfully required, and shall well and truly comply with the laws of this Commonwealth relating to collateral inheritance, and in all other respects with the laws of this Commonwealth, relating to his duty as executor, then this obligation to be void, otherwise of force and effect.
