

I desire that my household effects, except my plate, be equally divided among my three widowed daughters, Cecilia E. Cohen, Fanny E. Moise, and Sarah Moses, share and share alike, and any article they do not care for to be given to the Jewish Hospital.

Item: It is my will and I direct that my silver be weighed, and equally divided among my children now living, excepting my daughter, Amanda Moses, who, having ample, declined her share; the issue of any deceased child to stand in the place of their parent and to take only the share their parent would have taken if living.

My deceased son, Lionel L. Levy, received in his lifetime the silver, and the sum of two thousand dollars which I loaned him without interest, and in pursuance of an intention long since formed but not hitherto declared, I release and forgive the representatives of my said deceased son Lionel L. Levy, of said sum of two thousand dollars, and I direct that all evidence of such indebtedness be cancelled and given up to them.

The said sum of two thousand dollars which I have thus released and forgiven to the representatives of my said deceased son, Lionel L. Levy, and the silver heretofore given to him, I deem more than an equivalent for the respective shares which my remaining children will receive under this item of my will. It is therefore my desire, and I do will and direct that my silver plated ware and my furniture, not heretofore given and bequeathed, be equally divided among my children, except my daughter Amanda, who does not desire any part thereof; should any of my said children die in my life time, then the issue of such deceased child or children to take the share of their respective parent or parents.

Item: It is my desire, and I so will and direct, that the gifts which my children have respectively presented to me, be, at my death, returned to them.

As to the rest, residue and remainder of my estate, real, personal, or mixed, whatsoever and wheresoever, I direct shall be divided into equal parts or shares, one of which I give, devise and bequeath to each of my children, Cecilia E. Cohen, Fanny E. Moise, Sarah Moses, Septimo W. Collis, Amanda Moss, and Solomon L. Levy, their heirs and assigns. As respects the part or share hereby given or bequeathed to my daughter, Amanda Moss,

it is my will and desire that she should hold the same during her life, and after her death, so far as regards the income thereof, to her husband Lucien Moss, to use and enjoy the same during his natural life, and so far as regards the principal to such of my children or the issue of deceased children as my said daughter by her last will and testament, or instrument in the nature thereof, may direct and appoint, and in default of such appointment, then to my son and daughter herein named, and to the issue of those who may be deceased, the issue of any deceased child taking only the share their parent would have taken if living.

As respects the part or share hereby given, devised and bequeathed to my son Solomon L. Levy, it is my desire, and I so will and direct, that the real estate owned by me in the State of Washington, shall be conveyed to him on account of said part or share at the same price at which I bought it from him. But should such real estate have increased in value, at the time of the conveyance beyond the price so paid by me, then my said son Solomon L. Levy, shall account for and pay to my executrix herein named, for the benefit of my estate, the amount of such increase in value.

Item: Should any of my children contest my will, I desire and so declare that they shall forfeit the share and proportion which they would have been entitled to otherwise, and that the share and proportion which he or she may thus forfeit shall be equally divided among my other children above named, as part and parcel of my residuary estate.

Lastly, I do hereby nominate and appoint my daughter Sarah Moses, sole executrix of this my last will and testament, without being required or subject to giving security, or without liability to account to any court for her acts as such executrix.
