

side of Gladstone Avenue, a thousand feet more or less west of Collins Avenue, City of Cincinnati, Hamilton County, Ohio, the first section the third township and second fractional range in the Miami Purchase, the legal title of which is now in her; and also all my interest, if any, in the lot twenty-five (25) feet front on the south side of Columbia Avenue one hundred and sixty three $\frac{94}{100}$ (163.94) feet west of Collins Avenue, also in the City of Cincinnati, Hamilton County, Ohio, the legal title of which is also now in her.

I give, devise and bequeath to my wife Pauline Henke all undisputed interest in my benefit certificate numbered 1503, in the Germania Lodge, No. 38, Supreme Lodge of Protection, Knights and Ladies of Honor, for one thousand (1000) dollars entered into by me the second day of December 1878, which is now upon its face made payable to her. In case that my wife Pauline Henke died before I do I bequeath, give and devise to my two sons, Charles Henke and Harry Henke, all the property real and personal of which I die possessed to be divided equally between them, the youngest one having come of age.

I appoint my wife Pauline Henke my executrix of my estate, and desire that the Probate Court request no bond of her. Having already in former years given to the best of my ability to the help of my daughter by a former marriage, Carrie W. Hunt, I have not included her in this devise.

In testimony whereof, I have set my hand to this, my last will and testament, at Cincinnati, this 28th day of March, in the year of our Lord, one thousand eight hundred and ninety five.
