Letters of Administration

Whom these presents shall come, or may concern, and especially to Harry B. Ingersoll of Broken Bow, Nebraska, greeting.
Now ye, that whereas, John C. Ingersoll late of Custer County, Nebraska, deceased, lately died intestate leaving estate to be administered in said county, whereby the granting administration of said deceased, and also the auditing and finally discharging the account thereof, is within the jurisdiction of the County Court of said County, and

Whereas, Harry B. Ingersoll being entitled to the administration of said estate has given bond as required by law for the faithful execution of the trust of administrator of said estate, which has been duly proved and filed in said court

And therefore, expressing full confidence in your integrity and ability, do hereby these presents constitute and appoint you the said Harry B. Ingersoll, administrator of the estate of the said deceased, and do hereby authorize and empower you to take and have possession of all the real and personal estate except the homestead of said deceased, and to retain the rents issues, and profits thereof, until said estate shall have been settled, or until delivered over by order of said court, to the heirs of said deceased, and to demand, collect, recover and receive all and singular the debts, claims, demands, rights and shares in action which to the said deceased while living, and at the time of his death did belong.

And requiring you to keep in good tenantable repair all houses, buildings, and fences on said real estate, which may and shall be under your control, and in accordance with your bond, approved and filed as aforesaid, to make and return into said County Court within three months a true and perfect inventory of the real estate, and of all the goods, chattels, rights and credits of said deceased, which shall come to your possession or knowledge, to administer according to law all the goods, chattels, rights, credits and estate of said deceased, which shall come to your possession, or to the possession of any other person for you, and out of the same to pay and discharge all debts

and charges chargeable on the same, or such dividend thereon as shall be ordered and adjudged by said court, to render a just and true account of your administration to said court within one year from date, and at any other time when required by said court, and to perform all orders and judgments of said court by you to be performed in the premises.
