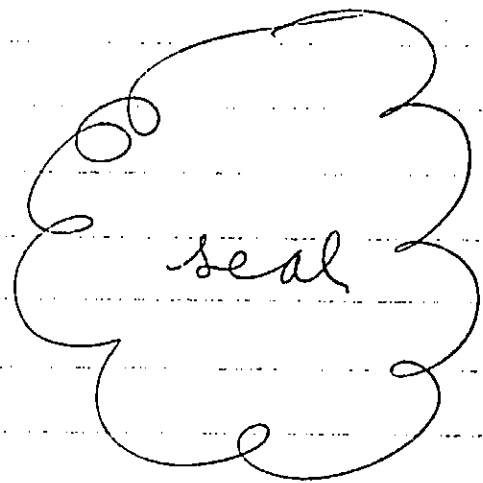

proof thereof, be duly recorded in Book of Wills given under my hand and seal at Ocala, this 27th day of February A.D. 1893.

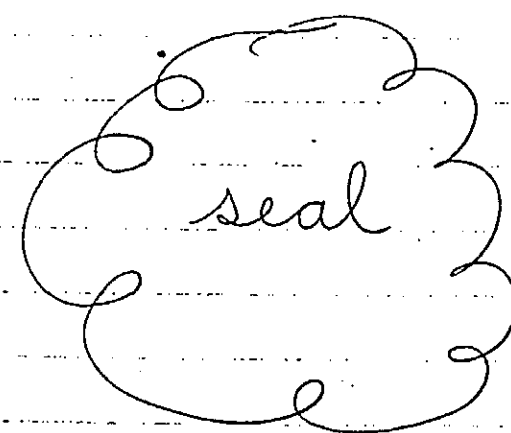
