

The sum of five hundred dollars (\$500) upon trust to invest, reinvest and keep the same invested, and to pay over said principal sum with accumulated interest unto my nephew Howard M. Hartzell upon his reaching the age of twenty-one years, but should said Howard M. Hartzell die before reaching said age, the said sum with accumulated interest shall become a part of my residuary estate.

Sixth. I give and bequeath to Rev. P. J. Petri of Atlantic City, New Jersey the sum of two hundred and fifty dollars (\$250) absolutely, for masses for the repose of the souls of my father David Doyle and my mother Mary Doyle.

Seventh. I give and bequeath to Rev. J. M. McParthy of St. Elizabeth's Roman Catholic Church of Philadelphia the sum of two hundred dollars (\$200) absolutely for masses for the repose of my soul.

Eighth. I give and bequeath unto each and every child which may be born to me after the date of this my will the sum of Five Hundred dollars (\$500) said sum to be the property of such child absolutely, and I do hereby declare that it is my will that any such child or children shall be excluded and barred from any participation in my estate real or personal, except as above provided.

Ninth. I hereby direct that all of the above bequests shall be paid free and clear of all collateral inheritance, internal revenue, or other taxes or deductions.

Tenth. All the rest residue and remainder of my estate, of whatsoever kind, character or description whether real, personal or mixed, and wheresoever situate, I give, devise and bequeath unto my husband William H. Henry, his heirs executors, administrators and assigns forever.

Lastly. I hereby nominate constitute and appoint my said husband William H. Henry the sole executor and trustee of this my last will and testament, and I do hereby authorize and empower my said executor and trustee to sell any or all of my real estate, at such times in such manner and for such price as in his discretion he may deem best.

and in case of any such sale or sales of my real estate I authorize my said executor to make, execute and deliver unto the purchaser or purchasers good and sufficient deeds and assurances for and of said real estate, without any liability on the part of any purchaser to see to the application of the purchase money.
