I give, devise and bequeath unto my wife, Abigail W. Kirkbride, all the rest, residue and remainder of my estate, both real and personal, wherever found and however situate, to have, hold, use and enjoy the rents, interest, issues and profits thereof during the term of her natural life; and from and after her decease I give, devise and bequeath my said estate unto my said daughters Lizzie J. Kirkbride and Annie C. Lippincott and my grandson Edward H. Kirkbride, share and share alike to them, their heirs and assigns forever.

I hereby constitute and appoint Jacob C. Lippincott and Lizzie J. Kirkbride, executor and executrix of this my last Will and testament and hereby authorize my said executor and executrix or the survivor of them, at any time or times during the life of my said wife, Abigail W. Kirkbride, to sell the whole or any part or parts of my residuary estate, either real or personal, together or in parcels, at public or private sale, and upon such terms and subject to such conditions, and in such manner and in all respects as they shall think fit, and for that purpose to make good and sufficient deed or deeds. I direct my said executor and executrix or the survivor of them to invest, reinvest and keep invested all my said residuary estate and to pay the rents, interest, issues and profits thereof to my said wife Abigail W. Kirkbride during the term of her natural life as hereinbefore set forth.
