

Testament. 1. I direct my Executor to pay all my just debts, funeral expenses and the costs and expenses of settling my estate as soon as practicable after my decease.

2. I give and devise my lot in the West Laurel Hill Cemetery No. 177 Omeron section to my brother Edmund P. Poole his heirs Executors and administrators.

3. I give and bequeath to him my said brother Edmund all my silverware consisting of forks, spoons and articles of that kind.

To my sister Emma my Trunk and clothing.

To my sister Eliza R. Bechell my gold watch and pendants.

To my niece Marion H. Williams my diamonds consisting of a pair of earrings, a pin set with diamonds and a solitaire ring.

4. I give and bequeath to my brother Washington P. Poole of the city of Harrisburg the sum of Twenty five hundred dollars.

5. The above gifts shall be clear of all collateral and other inheritance taxes, and to that end I direct that any such taxes shall be paid by my Executors out of my general Estate.

6. All the rest, residue and remainder of my estate and property real and personal I direct my Executor to convert into money and pay such proceeds to my said brother Edmund P. Poole for his use absolutely, he resides in the city of St. Paul, Minnesota.

7. For the purpose of making distribution of my Estate as aforesaid I authorize and empower my Executor to sell at his discretion all my securities and personal property excepting what I have specifically bequeathed and make good and sufficient delivery and transfers thereof without liability on the part of any corporation or agency that may be responsible for the approval of transfers of Bonds or stocks. And to sell at either public or private sale all my real Estate wherever situated for such prices and upon such terms as to him shall seem best and to execute and deliver good and sufficient deeds of conveyance for the same, without liability on the part of any purchaser to see to the application of the purchase money. At the present time the only real Estate I own is the property I live in No. 211 North Twentieth street, Philadelphia and the property in Atlantic City, New Jersey, No. 132 Atlantic Avenue, corner of New Hampshire Avenue, but the above power and direction shall apply to any real Estate that I may own at the time of my death.

8. Provided however that as to my personal property my Executor may transfer in kind any of my securities not required to be sold for the payment of the

legacy to my brother Washington or for the settlement of my Estate to my brother Edmund if he shall so desire, as part of the residuary bequest to him.

9. I nominate and appoint W. Moylan Lansdale of the city of Philadelphia the Executor of this my will.

I Marion G. Poole declare the following to be a correct copy of my last Will and Testament:

I direct that my Executor shall not sell any of the items of my property herein named. I give to my brother Edmund P. Poole the following three articles:

1st. A Musical box with stand and Disks.

2nd. The brown velvet couch now in my sitting room.

3rd. Library table.

And I wish that they shall be shipped to him at the expense of my Estate.

I give to my Executor the following articles:

1st. A Sampler in a narrow oak frame, worked by my Grand mother at the age of twelve years.

2nd. Marriage certificate of my Grand parents framed in oak.

3rd. A pair of silver plated candle sticks with snuffer and tray over one hundred and fifty years old.

My Executor being aware of my wish to have those articles of family interest kept within my family, I am satisfied that he will in his judgment make such disposition of them as shall best carry my wishes into effect.

With the above modifications I ratify and confirm my will of March 30th 1903.
