

trustee shall pay over said net income to said Esther Y. Fuller from time to time and in such amounts as said trustee in her or his discretion shall deem best and only as said trustee shall see fit and proper. Should my said daughter Esther Y. Fuller cause any trouble in the settlement of my estate or make any contest over my will, then in such case I give and devise premises No. 3301 Pacific Avenue aforesaid (or the proceeds thereof if the same is sold) together with the contents thereof unto my daughter Emma E. Motz her heirs and assigns forever free from all trusts and conditions and in that event I order and direct my said daughter Emma E. Motz to pay to Esther Y. Fuller the sum of five hundred dollars cash.

I give and devise premises at the corner of Pacific Avenue and Boston Avenue being number 3401 Pacific Avenue in Atlantic City New Jersey unto my adopted son William Dolan Motz his heirs and assigns forever. I give and bequeath the contents of said premises unto my adopted son William Dolan Motz absolutely. I give and bequeath my automobile its robes and tools unto my adopted son William Dolan Motz. This devise and bequest to my adopted son William Dolan Motz shall take effect immediately upon my decease and my said adopted son William Dolan Motz shall have the right to immediate possession of said premises contents thereof, automobile etc. I give and bequeath the sum of Four thousand dollars unto Michael Joseph Berrose. I direct my executors to pay this legacy to Michael Joseph Berrose prior to making any payment to my son Francis on account of my gift and devise to him in the residuary clause of my will.

It may be that some ^{of my} property has been conveyed to me in the name of "Maxwell Motz" and it may be that some moneys shall be due my estate in this name. If so my executors will see that such moneys are received and such properties conveyed in my proper name "Maximilian Motz". I have been called "Maxwell" for many years by some people and I have become known to many people by this name and by reason of this some property I have bought may have been transferred to me in this name but my proper name is "Maximilian Motz" and I direct my executors to use my proper name in the settlement of my estate.

All the rest residue and remainder of my estate real personal and mixed I give devise and bequeath unto my son Francis P. Motz his heirs and assigns forever.

I nominate constitute and appoint my son Francis P. Motz and Michael Joseph Berrose to be the executors of this my last will and testament. In the event of the decease of either of my executors the survivor shall discharge all the duties of the executor.
