"Codicil"

This is a codicil to be added to the last will and testament of me, John Myers, of the city of Atlantic City, county of Atlantic and State of New Jersey, said will being dated December fifth, nineteen hundred and three.

I direct that if my wife Rose H. Myers, dies before my children reach the age of twenty one years, that the share of such children, as given to them by my said will, shall be held in trust by my said trustees for said children until they severally reach the age of twenty one years and the income thereof used for their support and education. In case the income shall not be sufficient to properly support and educate said children I authorize my trustees to use as much of the principal fund in their hands as they may deem necessary.

I also appoint my said brothers Daniel A. and Jacob L. Myers, guardians of my said children upon the death of my wife.

In witness whereof, to the present writing, which I hereby declare to be a codicil to my last will and testament and which I direct to be added thereto and to be taken as part thereof, I have set my hand, and seal this seventh day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and three.
