

"Will of Erhard Haushalter"

Last Will: I, Erhard Haushalter, of the city of Philadelphia, State of Pennsylvania, being of sound mind and memory, and considering the uncertainty of this frail and transitory life, do therefore make, ordain, publish and declare, this to be my last Will and Testament: That is to say,

First, after all my lawful debts are paid and discharged, I give devise and bequeath all my estate, real, personal and mixed to my beloved wife Elizabeth Haushalter born Schlachter to have and to hold the same during her natural life and after her death to our respective heirs absolutely forever.

Second I make, constitute and appoint my said wife Elizabeth Haushalter to be executrix of this my last will and testament, hereby revoking all former wills by me made.

In witness whereof, I have herewith subscribed my name, and affixed my seal, the fifteenth day of August, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty three.
