I give and bequeath unto my beloved wife Abbie Scull all my household goods and chattels and all manner of personal property whatsoever to her own use and disposal.


I give and devise unto my beloved wife Abbie Scull all my Real Estate of whatsoever kind and wheresoever situated to her and her disposal absolutely.
