pearing that Anna T. Mivison and Mrs. E. C. Gilbert sisters

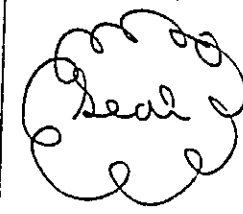
and next of kin have renounced their right of administration
