

Hickman share and share alike until the youngest of them shall have arrived at the age of twenty one years at which time I direct my said Trustee to pay, or cause to be paid, over unto our said daughter Dorothy and Marie Hickman all of my said residuary property or estate in equal shares or parts & in the event of the death of either of my said daughters before their arrival at the age of twenty one years without leaving child or children her surviving I direct that the survivor of them shall have and take the one half part or share that my deceased sister would have taken if living, and that my entire estate shall be paid over to my surviving daughter at and upon her arrival at the age of twenty one years. In the event of the death of either of my said daughters before their arrival at the age of twenty one years leaving a child or children her surviving I direct that the one half part or share of my said estate at and upon the time when the youngest of my said daughters would have arrived at the age of twenty one years shall go to and be paid over unto each and every of the child or children of my said daughter by dying in equal shares or parts. In the event of the death of both of my said children before their arrival at the age of twenty one years without leaving a child or children them surviving, I give, agree and bequeath all my said residuary estate so held in trust for the uses and purposes herein specified to my said husband Walter Atlee Hickman his heirs and assigns absolutely. I hereby authorize, and in power my said Trustee at any time after my decease at his discretion to sell and dispose of any part of my real or personal estate at public or private sale for the best price that can be obtained for the same and by proper deed or deeds of conveyance to grant, convey and assure the same to the purchaser or purchasers thereof in fee simple free from all liability for or on account of the application of the purchase money and free from all liens, debts contracts or engagements whatsoever. Lastly I nominate constitute and appoint my husband Walter Atlee Hickman Executive Trustee to this my last Will and Testament.
