Will of L. H. Parkhurst.

Hammononton, New Jersey. Dec. 1900.  
I, L. H. Parkhurst do make this my last Will and Testament. 1st I give and bequeath unto my beloved wife Amelia S. Parkhurst all of my stock in the Peoples Bank of Hammononton New Jersey and one third of all other property both Real & Personal that I may die possessed of except one gold watch & chain, of which I am possessed of one and bequeath unto my wife, son Charles W. Parkhurst, the gold watch and chain that belonged to his Mother Sarah H. Parkhurst and nothing else, as the money expended in his education amounts to more than half of my other son's will have coming to them after my debt is paid. 3rd I give and bequeath unto my second son William Hubbard Parkhurst one third of all the property both Real & Personal that I may die possessed of except the stock in the Peoples Bank of Hammononton N.J. and gold watch and chain mentioned above. 4th I give and bequeath unto my youngest son George Howard Parkhurst one third of all the property I may die possessed of both Real and Personal except the stock in the Peoples Bank of Hammononton N.J. and gold watch & chain mentioned above. 5th I appoint Amelia S. Parkhurst, William Hubbard Parkhurst, and George Howard Parkhurst joint executors of this my last Will and testament and direct that they shall conduct my farm as a whole for a sufficient number of years to determine whether my son William H. Parkhurst can retain the farm and pay off the other two shares there in at a reasonable price to be determined by them. In case that my wife Amelia S. Parkhurst should die before me, I hereby direct that all my property both Real and Personal that I may die possessed of except the gold watch and chain above mentioned is divided equally between my two youngest sons William Hubbard Parkhurst and George Howard Parkhurst and that they conduct the farm jointly until such time as William Hubbard Parkhurst can determine whether he wishes to pay George Howard Parkhurst for his share in cash at a reasonable price to be determined by them, or not.
