Milton. - One seventh thereof to my daughter Susan R. Cannell of the city of Philadelphia, wife of J. Skipwith Cannell. - One seventh thereof to my daughter Lucy Pancoast Smith of the city of Philadelphia wife of H. Cavalier Smith. - One seventh thereof to my son Daniel Leeds Miller of Lyons Farms, Union County, New Jersey. - One seventh thereof to my son Horace W. Miller of Richmond Virginia. - One seventh thereof to my daughter Rachel Bedford Ravens of the city of Philadelphia, widow of Franklin Ignier Ravens. And I have advanced the sum of two thousand six hundred and eighty dollars (\$2680.) to my son Daniel Lees Miller for business purposes I direct that this sum be deducted without interest from his share of my estate hereinbefore bequeathed to him.

As I have also advanced on various occasions different sums of money to my son Horace W. Miller, I direct that the sum of five hundred dollars (\$500.) be deducted without interest from his share of my estate hereinbefore bequeathed to him.

All presents given to me at anytime by any of my seven children are to be returned to them. All my silver, glass, china, furniture and household goods I leave to my seven children to divide amongst themselves as evenly as they can. My clothing and what little jewelry and lace I may have I leave to my five daughters to divide amongst themselves.
