 It appearing from the petition of William John Hamilton of the City of Atlantic City and State of New Jersey and Samuel Mills, Jr. of the City of Philadelphia and State of Pennsylvania, filed herein, that Ellen Hamilton late of the City of Atlantic City, in the County of Atlantic and State of New Jersey did on the Twenty-sixth day of April 1907, having first duly made and executed a paper writing purporting to be her last will and testament, in and by which she appointed Sarah Mills of the City of Philadelphia, State of Pennsylvania, sole executrix thereof, and it further appearing that the said Sarah Mills did on the thirty-first day of May, 1907 without having proved said will, and it further appearing that Eliza Bruner, Samuel H. Mills and Annie Mills have all renounced their right to letters of administration and have requested the appointment of your petitioners;

And the Surrogate having inquired into the circumstances taken proof and being satisfied of the genuineness of the will heretofore, the validity of its execution, and the competency of the testatrix, and William John Hamilton and Samuel Mills, Jr. being in my judgment fit persons to administer the estate of the said testatrix;

It is on this sixth day of June A. D. 1908, adjudged that the instrument offered for probate in this matter is the last will and testament of Ellen Hamilton, deceased, and the said will is hereby admitted to probate; and it is ordered that Letters of Administration with the will Annexed be issued thereon to the said William John Hamilton and Samuel Mills, Jr. upon the giving by them of a bond as required by law
