Wills: unto each of my grandchildren Lily, Christian, David, Joseph,izzie and Daisy Biegelbach, children of my son Frank Biegelbach, deceased, now living in Port Republic, County of Atlantic State of New Jersey I charge my executor and trustee to pay the sum of one dollar, which I give to them and their heirs and assigns forever. My reason for not bequeathing a larger amount to them is because, their father my son Frank, deceased, was given a farm by his father, with the understanding that it was his portion of the inheritance he would receive after my decease.
