Codicil
Sebastian Oberst of Egg Harbor City, in the county of Atlantic and State of New Jersey having made his last Will and Testament made on the day of the eleventh day of February A. D. eighteen hundred and ninety eight do now make this codicil to be taken as a part of the same.

As hereby notified and confirmed said will in every respect excepting items three and four from both of which items the name of my son Lorenz is to be expunged.

I give and bequeath to him, my son Lorenz, the sum of twenty five hundred dollars and hereby charge my executor named and appointed in my last will and testament above mentioned to pay said legacy of twenty five hundred dollars in manner following, that is to say: One thousand dollars to be paid to him immediately after my death and the remaining fifteen hundred dollars ten years after the date of my decease.

I wish more give and bequeath two hundred dollars to the Roman Catholic St. Nicholas Church of this city.
I finally give my executor fifty dollars to be expended for masses to be said for the repose of my soul.

I desire that the fifteen hundred dollars due my son Lorenz ten years after my death be invested by my executor and that 4% interest be paid him at the end of each year.
