To George Wood the old Desk & Bookcase in sitting room. It belonged to his
Great Grandmother Mary Taylor.

To Juliana Wood the high chest of drawers now in my front Chamber date 1735

To Walter Wood the old club foot table in my front entry, & the ancient high
backed wood arm chair now in the sitting room.

To Stuart Wood the wooden Chest of drawers now in the 3rd story back
building, date perhaps 1689

To Anne & Harriet Randolph the pair of circular topped mahogany dining
tables belonging to their Grand Mothers keeping out it.

To Edward Randolph the old Desk & Bookcase & Trunk that my father purchased
abroad & marked with Brass nails (E. R. P.) now in the 3rd story back
