Lastly I hereby nominate constitute and appoint my beloved husband Jesse O. Riedesel to be the Executor of this my last will and Testament and I hereby authorize and empower my said Executor either for the payment of my debts the settlement of my estate or for any other purpose whenever in his judgment it may be deemed advisable to sell and dispose of all or any part of my real estate either at public or private sale for the best price or prices upon such term or terms and in such way and manner as to him shall seem best and to sign seal execute acknowledge and deliver all necessary deed or deeds or other assurances in the law for conveying a fee simple title to the purchaser or purchasers thereof and to receive and receipt for the purchase money so that the purchaser or purchasers thereof shall in no wise be liable for the application or for any mis-application or non-application of the same and I hereby revoke all other wills by me at any time heretofore made and declare this only to be and contain my last will and Testament.
