And all the best and residue of the said Goods, Chattels, and Credits, together with the proceeds of any sales of Real Estate the said Administratrix may make under the will of decedent, which shall be found remaining upon said Administratrix account (the same being first examined and allowed by the Orphans' Court of the City and County of Philadelphia) shall deliver and pay unto each person or persons respectively as the said Orphans' Court, by their decree and sentence pursuant to the true intent and meaning of the last Will and Testament of the said deceased, and the law now in force in this Commonwealth, shall limit and appoint and shall well and truly comply with the laws of this Commonwealth relating to collateral inheritance. And if it shall hereafter appear that any later Will and Testament was made by the said deceased, and the same shall be proved according to law, if the said Administratrix, as aforesaid, being thereunto required, do surrender the said Letters of Administration in the Register's Office aforesaid, then this obligation is to be void - otherwise to be and remain in full force.
