I, Eliza Deffer of Atlantic County, Atlantic City, New Jersey, being of sound mind and memory do hereby make my last will and testament in the following manner.

First, I give and bequeath my real estate to be equally divided between my son Thos. S. Deffer and my daughters Julia C., Sadie M., and Flora G. Deffer in case of the death of my son Thos. S. Deffer or my daughters Julia C., Sadie M. and Flora G. Deffer then their share is to be equally divided among those of my children that are still living that I have just mentioned (Thos. S. Deffer, Julia C., Sadie M., and Flora G. Deffer) and they can sell or dispose of it according to their own discretion.

Second, I give and bequeath to my son Martin Deffer, the sum of five dollars in case of his death to be paid to his son Ed. Deffer.

Third, I also give and bequeath to my daughter Julia C. my gold watch.

To my daughter Flora G. I bequeath my gold chain. All the rest of my personal property I bequeath to my daughter Sadie M. Deffer.

My Grandson Martin Chas. Deffer as he is making his home with me I leave him in charge of my children Thos. S. Deffer, and my daughters Julia, Sadie, and Flora who are to take charge of him, educate, help clothe and give him my assistance that he may need till he is able to support himself. I appoint my son Thos. S. Deffer sole executor of this my last will and testament. In testimony whereof I hereunto set my hand and seal and real publish and declare this to be my last will and testament in presence of the witnesses named below this twenty sixth day of November, in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and two.
