

any deceased child or children of my said daughter shall take the share of his, her or their parent or parents upon the attainment by him, her or them of the age of twenty-five years, and until such time as the child or children or lineal descendants of my said daughter shall severally attain the age of twenty-five years, the share of any such child, children or lineal descendants shall be safely and securely invested by my surviving executor and trustee in first mortgage securities or income producing properties situated in the State of New Jersey or elsewhere and the income therefrom shall be paid to the least representative or representatives of such child, children or lineal descendants during his, her or their minority and to him, her or them from the time of the attainment by him, her or them of his, her or their majority until such time as he, she or they shall severally attain the age of twenty-five years where the principal sum shall be paid to such child, children or lineal descendants.

Item Seventh: - In the event of the death of my daughter without leaving lineal descendants then it is my will and wish that my husband, if then surviving my said daughter shall take her share of the income of my estate, and in like event and on the death of my husband, my surviving executor and trustee shall pay to my son, Harry, son of H. W. Bath, he then being alive the sum of Five Thousand Dollars and in like event the payment of the annuity provided to be paid to my sister, Mary A. Gibson in Item Fourth of this my will, she then being alive, shall cease and determine, and my said executor and trustee shall set apart from my estate the sum of twenty thousand dollars and shall pay the income thereof semi-annually in equal shares to my sisters, Catherine P. Salbreath, and Mary A. Gibson, and to the survivor of them during her life, they or either of them then being alive, and upon the death of both of my said sisters, they or either of them surviving me, the said sum of Twenty Thousand Dollars, so as aforesaid bequeathed, shall be divided equally into three shares and paid to my nephews, Warren G. Salbreath, Walter G. Salbreath, (sons of my said sister Catherine P. Salbreath) and to Harold Gibson, (son of my sister Mary A. Gibson) and if either of my said nephews die leaving issue such issue shall take the share of his, her or their deceased parent, and if any of my said nephews die before the termination of said trust and the distribution of said sum of Twenty Thousand Dollars and without leaving issue surviving him then his share of said sum shall be equally divided among the survivors of said nephews if there be two survivors and Ten Thousand Dollars only shall be given to the

sole survivor if there be but one surviving at the time of the happening of this event, and after the death of my husband and in the event of the death of my daughter without leaving lineal descendants and in the event that both of my sisters here-decease me then it is my will and I bequeath the sum of Six Thousand Six Hundred and Fifty Six Dollars to each of my said nephews, and if either of my said nephews die leaving issue such issue shall take the share of his, her or their deceased parent Item Eighth: - All the just residue and remainder of my estate remaining after the contingencies expressed in Item Seventh hereof, and after the payment of the legacies therein directed to be paid I give, devise and bequeath to the Trustees of the Atlantic City Hospital of Atlantic City, New Jersey, and I direct and it is my will that the proceeds of said estate be expended by said Trustees in founding and establishing a building or an annex to the then buildings of said institution, to be used exclusively for the accommodation and care of women and children and to be known as the "A. M. Jobby Memorial Building" if already established and to provide for the establishment thereof if not already established, leaving to the said Trustees the privilege of using their discretion as to the methods to be adopted in the appropriation of the proceeds of said estate so as to carry out the full intent and meaning of this bequest.

It is my will and I direct that my executors and trustees and any two of them shall have power to sell and dispose of any portions of my estate, real, personal or mixed, at public or private sale at such times and upon such terms and in such manner as to them shall seem meet and that the Atlantic City Safe Deposit and Trust Company of Atlantic City as my surviving executor and trustee shall have like powers after securing the approval of the Orphans' Court of Atlantic County to each proposed sale of any portion of the whole thereof of my estate.

I direct my executors and trustees to invest all monies and the income derived from my estate, and herein directed to be invested in first mortgage securities on improved real estate situated in the State of New Jersey or elsewhere as to them shall seem most desirable.

I nominate and appoint my husband, Albert M. Jordan as one of the executors and trustees of this my will to continue subject during his life; I nominate and appoint my daughter, Margaret Johnson Jordan Bath, as an executrix and trustee of this my will to continue as such during her life, and having full confidence in both of them I direct that neither of them be required to give bond for the proper execution of this trust and I nominate and appoint the Atlantic City Safe Deposit and
