Eberle, 1736 Gillingham Street are held and firmly bound unto the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in the sum of Two hundred dollars, to be paid to the said Commonwealth: To which payment well and truly to be made, we bind ourselves jointly and severally, for and in the whole, our heirs, executors and administrators, and each and every of them firmly by these presents.

Sealed with our seals. Dated the 5th day of May in the year of our Lord One Thousand eight Hundred and Ninety One (1891)

The Condition of this Obligation, is That if the above bounden Susan A. Green Administratrix cum testamento annexo of all and singular the Goods, Chattels and Credits of Thomas H. Green deceased, do immediately publish for Creditors &c., and make or cause to be made a true and perfect inventory and inventories according to law, of all and singular the Goods, Chattels, and Credits of the said deceased, which shall have come, or shall come, to the hands, possession or knowledge of the said Administratrix as aforesaid or unto the hands or possession of any other person or persons for her and the same so made to exhibit, or cause to be exhibited, in the Register's Office in the County of Philadelphia, within thirty days from the date hereof, and the same Goods, Chattels, and credits and all other the Goods, Chattels, and Credits of the said deceased at the time of his death, which at any time after shall come to the hands or possession of said Administratrix as aforesaid, or unto the hands or possession of any other person or persons for her do well and truly administer according to law. And further do make or cause to be made, a just and true account of her said Administration, within one year of the date hereof, or when thereunto legally required.
